**BUS TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM SANTA CLARA, NEW MEXICO**

ROUND TRIP. The USNSCC Bataan Battalion RMR 15-2 has contracted bus service for Cadets to be transported to Santa Clara from Albuquerque on Wednesday, 15 July 2009, and to return Cadets to Albuquerque on Saturday, 25 July 2009, for the Graduation Ceremony.

Space is limited. Arrangements are on a first-come basis. Advance payment only.

PRICE. The fee for round trip bus transportation Albuquerque-Santa Clara-Albuquerque is forty-five dollars (\$45.00) per Cadet. Cash is preferred. Checks and money orders will be made payable to *USNSCC* or the *Bataan Battalion*. Checks or money orders payable to Bataan Military Academy will not be accepted. Payment will not be accepted on date of departure. Map to Santa Clara enclosed for Cadets not riding the bus. Trip to Santa Clara is approximately 4.50 hours one way.

Deadline for registration and all fees: Tuesday 24 June 2009.

**CADETS TO ARRIVE IN DRESS WHITE UNIFORMS**

On 15 July 2009, all Cadets will report to the NMARNG training command in Dress White uniforms. However, on 15 July 2009, Cadets traveling on USNSCC bus, will arrive at Bataan Military Academy, 8001 Mountain Road Place NE, Albuquerque, at 0730 wearing summer (short sleeve) dungarees. (Cadets will be on time. Bus will not be delayed for late arrivals.) Cadets will wear summer (short sleeve) dungaree uniforms during bus trip. Cadets will pack Dress White uniform at top of Sea Bag. Once these Cadets arrive in Santa Clara, they will change into Whites. Then, they will report to command in Dress Whites with Sea Bag for check-in and inspection.

Re: USNSCC Sea Lion III Instructions for Recruit Training, POLA, and FIELD OPS SEABEE

Training Dates: 15-25 July 2009

Location: New Mexico Army National Guard (NMANG), Santa Clara, New Mexico (7 miles east of Silver City)

### ALL PARENTS AND CADETS, READ AND FOLLOW REGULATIONS

- (a) Cadets will report to the NMANG facility for training between 1300-1600 hours on Wednesday 15 July 2009 – no exceptions. No early or late arrivals.
- (b) USNSCC enrollment and training registration/orders are required. Medical release forms (included in enrollment packet) must be completed and signed by the parent and a physical examination form signed by a physician must be on file. If a Cadet is to be administered prescription or over-the-counter medication, the official permission form must be signed by the parent and submitted to command.
- (c) Cadets will secure all uniforms and have uniforms prepared with USNSCC patches and devices in accordance with regulations cited in the *Basic Military Requirements* (BMR). When school starts in August, Cadets will need additional sets of uniforms with Bataan Military Academy patches.
- (d) Recruits will complete the *Basic Military Requirements* assignments 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 by reading and answering questions on provided answer sheets. Completed answer sheets will have been submitted. Cadets will have received a passing grade to attend training.
- (e) Secure and prepare all items in accordance with the USNSCC Sea Lion III Sea Bag Lists. No exceptions.
- (f) Approximately one week before the training begins, Cadets should reduce intake of sugar and milk products.
- (g) Recruit Cadets are not allowed to possess money.
- (h) Cadets will pay enrollment fee of \$170.00 for Recruit Training or other advanced training (checks and money orders payable to USNSCC or Bataan Battalion). There is a \$25.00 fee for all returned checks. There is a \$45 fee for roundtrip bus transportation. See below.
- (i) Parents will hand deliver any required medications to the designated adult officer on 15 July 2009. Prescription medication must be in original prescription container with physician approved instructions. Parents will include only amount of medication needed for the ten (10) day training. Excess medication will *not* be returned at conclusion of training. Cadets are not authorized to deliver medications to Officers nor are Cadets allowed to possess medications.
- (j) NOTE: Cadets will report for training check-in to NMANG Santa Clara base in Dress White Uniforms with Sea Bag and gear. Cadets riding the commercial bus, will report to the Academy parking lot no later than 0730 hours on 15 July 2009, NO LATE ARRIVALS. BUS WILL LEAVE ON TIME. Cadets will wear summer (short-sleeve) dungaree uniform during bus trip. Dress White uniforms will be packed at top of Sea Bag. Cadets will change into Dress Whites upon arrival at NMARNG Santa Clara and then, Cadets will report to Command in Dress White Uniform for check-in and inspection.

- (k) Parents may transport Cadets to Santa Clara training site. Parents are not to enter the base building. A round-trip commercial bus service will be available for \$45.00. All fees will be paid in advance. See attached note. First come basis. Only pre-paid Cadets will be allowed to be transported. Payment not accepted at time of departure. Only checks and money orders payable to USNSCC or the Bataan Battalion. There is a \$25.00 fee for returned checks.
- (l) Parents are not allowed to enter the military base facility. Parents will use drop off and pick-up areas in front parking lot of NMARNG Santa Clara. Cadets will report to interior command.
- (m) Cadets found in violation of training regulations (gear or behavior violations) may be separated from the training. In such cases, parents will be notified by the Commanding Officer to come to Santa Clara for their child. Parents are responsible for all transportation expenses. There are no REFUNDS for training expenses.
- (n) USNSCC, Bataan Battalion is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Cadets are to use permanent marker to identify all gear, uniform items and clothing. This is strictly enforced. Command is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Investigation of lost or stolen items is at discretion of Command. Command is not responsible for contraband items.
- (o) Recruit Cadets are not allowed to make telephone calls (or send text messages) during the training. Cadets are not allowed to receive telephone calls during the training. Parents, family and friends may send letters via USPS.
- (p) Cadets, parents, friends and Cadets may exchange USPS mail; however, privacy is suspended. Contraband as described in regulations via USPS mail is prohibited. Mail may be opened for security purposes. Release form with parent signature is required. Address mail to:

- (q) ATTENTION: In the event of an emergency, the parent will be notified; otherwise, the safety and security of your child is our utmost concern. Call the emergency number ONLY in dire, serious emergency cases. All calls will be screened by USNSCC personnel answering service. Emergency calls only are forwarded to site Command. All emergency calls are to be directed to 1 (505) 507-4670. This number will not be activated until 0800 hours on 15 July 2009. For information, call LT Reed in Headquarters during business hours at 292-5588.
- (r) Graduation Ceremonies will be held on Saturday 25 July 2009 at 1600 hours at the Bataan Corregidor Memorial Park on Lomas near Girard in Albuquerque. Parents, family members and friends are invited to attend. Bring a camera. A social cookout meal will follow. Parents are invited to sign-up at the Academy Headquarters and bring a dish or other item contributing to the meal. Call or see LT Reed in Headquarters for sign-up. Hamburgers and hotdogs will be provided. Parents will receive an invitation to the ceremony via USPS.
- (s) **Q & A Session with Commanding Officer: A Recruit Training Parent/Cadet/CO meeting will be on Tuesday 16 June 2009 at 1900 hours. Location: Bataan Military Academy, 8001 Mountain Road Place NE, Albuquerque. Forms requiring parent signatures and information about RT will be provided.**

- 1 Current UNSNCC ID card or proof of registration
- 1 Sleeping Bag/Pillow/White Pillow Case
- 1 Flat white Sheet
- 1 Light weight blanket, blue or black
- 2-3 Bath towels, wash clothes, white only
- 1 Padlock w/2 keys, neck chain for 1 key or Combination lock, 1 key/combo in service jacket
- 1 Dress White Uniform w/flashes attached
- Dress Uniform accessories, white belt w/silver buckle and tip, neckerchief, dixie cup/beret/  
combination cover, black dress shoes (leather), name plate, ribbons
- 1 Military raincoat/jacket/parka (solid navy blue or black) No logos or print
- 1 BDU Uniform w/flashes, eight point cover, no boonie (Aussie) covers
- 1 Blue Coveralls w/flashes, blue ball cap, black belt w/silver tip
- 2 Pair sturdy, supportive athletic shoes, dark color, proper fit, good condition
- 1 Pair of sweats, blue or black, no colors or print
- 6-8 White T-shirts
- 3-4 Brown T-shirts
- 6-8 Pair White socks, crew length, no low cut or ankle length
- 6-8 Pair Black socks, crew length, no low cut or ankle length
- 9 Sets white underwear (sports bras recommended for females), bring enough for entire training
- 1 Jock strap for males
- 2 PT shirts, USNSCC only, no navy shirts
- 2 PT shorts, navy blue or black, solid color, no logos, prints or strips
- 1 Pair shower shoes(flip-flops)
- 1 Shoe shine kit, paste only w/cotton balls or rag
- 1 Sewing kit
- 1 Swim suit (females are required one-piece suits), black or navy blue
- 1 Canteen with web carrier or camel-pack
- 1 Set of summer sleep wear (PJ's)
- 1 Notebook, 2 pens, 2 pencils (stamps and envelopes optional)
- 1-2 Age appropriate books for reading, (not trashy stuff)
- Religious reading material, if desired
- 1 Flashlight w/extra batteries
- 1 Pair working gloves

All Cadets are to bring personal hygiene products, *i.e.*, shampoo/conditioner, lotion, sunscreen, lip balm, bath soap/body wash, tooth brush/toothpaste, body powder, shaving kit, hair brush, deodorant. NO ELECTRIC RAZORS. NO BLOW DRYERS.

All items must be stenciled/marked (w/permanent marker) with Cadet's last four numbers of SSN. Dress uniforms will be marked with permanent ink on the manufacturer's tag. Command not responsible for lost or stolen items.

All items on this list are required. Minimum numbers are listed. NO LAUNDRY WILL BE DONE AT THIS TRAINING. Females MUST have appropriate materials for US Navy regulation grooming standards. No scrunchies. Females MUST bring feminine hygiene products for possible personal use.

NO WEAPONS, TOBACCO PRODUCTS, DRUGS/ALCOHOL or any other items not listed. Medication (prescription or OTC) must be in original container. Medication Form must be signed by parent and on file. Medications MUST be submitted to adult Officer prior to Cadet check-in.

NO CELL PHONES OR ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT OF ANY KIND WILL BE USED DURING TRAINING. NO DUNGAREES FOR POLA CADETS.

1. All items must be stenciled or marked (permanent marker) with the Cadet's last name or initials. Dress uniforms will be marked with permanent ink on the manufacturer's tags. Neatly and out of sight.
2. All items on this list are required, however they are minimum numbers. More may be brought, but remember space is limited. High quality athletic shoes are advised.
3. Cadet contraband items include wallets, money, cameras, food, candy, drinks, medication (prescription or OTC); tobacco products, inappropriate magazines, weapons, drugs/alcohol, and any other items not included on the list above. Items other than those listed on the Sea Bag list will be confiscated. Cadet may be separated from training at discretion of Commanding Officer. USNSCC is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
4. Females must have appropriate materials to keep hair within US Navy regulation grooming standard. No scrunchies; black braided bands, gel, hairspray, etc.. Females must bring their own sanitary supplies. Sports bras only.
5. NOTE: Medications are to be in original bottles with prescription instructions. Must be delivered by parent (not Cadet) to medical staff on 15 July 2009 and accompanied with OFFICIAL MEDICATION FORM signed by parent. Parents will issue only enough for the ten day training. None returned.

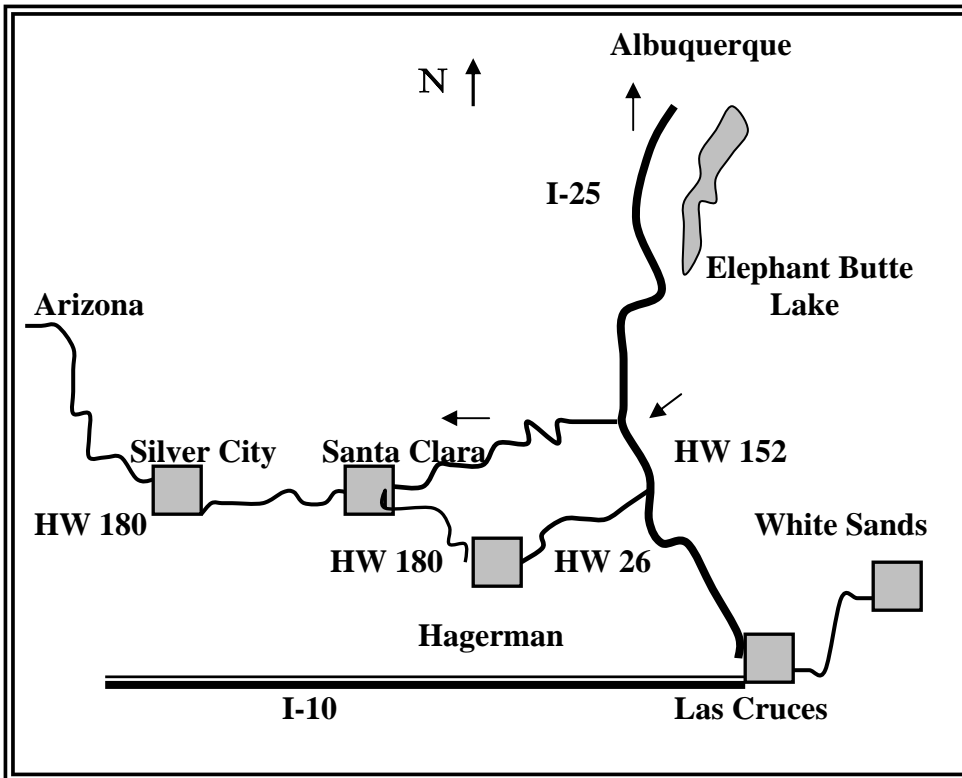
