Cadets are not required to wear uniforms. Modest school clothing should be worn.

Please bring the following items: **Copy of Current Immunizations, money for replacement of books (if applicable), and money for USNSCC dues. Only cash, checks, and money orders will be accepted.**

~REGISTRATION STATIONS~

CADETS ARE REQUIRED TO VISIT EACH STATION AND HAVE THEIR BUFF COLORED CARD INITIALED AS PROOF OF HAVING COMPLETED THE ACTIVITY OF THAT STATION. THE BUFF COLORED CARD WILL BE COLLECTED AT THE END OF THE REGISTRATION PROCESS. BUFF CARDS SHOULD NOT LEAVE THE SCHOOL.

STATION 1 –

BUFF COLORED CARD DISTRIBUTION & COLLECTION OF BMA FINES: All Cadets will be required to pick up their Buff Card at Station 1.

Cadets who do not have textbook fines will be instructed to proceed to the next station.

TEXTBOOK FINES: Returning Cadets who did not return their textbooks to the Bookroom before Registration will be responsible to pay for the replacement of the book(s) before continuing the registration process. Cadets who have outstanding books will find an attachment to this letter. Call Officer Geddie at 292-5588 if you have any questions on returning books. *Only cash, checks, and money orders will be accepted.*

PLEASE RETURN TEXTBOOKS BY THURSDAY, 04 AUGUST 2011 BETWEEN 0900 -1200 TO AVOID CHARGES AND DELAYS.

STATION 2 – NURSE STATION/ IMMUNIZATION RECORDS: All returning and new Cadets will bring current proof of immunizations. The school nurse will verify the information and maintain the record. If shot record is not current, the cadet will not proceed in the registration process.

STATION 3– USNSCC ID CARDS: Cadets will proceed to the Computer Lab to have their pictures taken for the USNSCC ID Card.

STATION 4 – COMPLETE REGISTRATION CARD (Mess Hall): Parents and Cadets will update school records and complete the Home Language Survey. Please be prepared to update names, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, place of employment, Emergency Contact Information, family doctor’s name and contact information.

STATION 5 – TITLE I CARDS: All parents will complete the **Family Application for Title I Program Eligibility School Year 2011-2012**. The information you provide is used to determine the Free & Reduced Lunch Program rate (FRLP) for Bataan Military Academy. That rate is used to determine if the school is eligible for federal dollars from **TITLE I FUNDING**. Our school may be eligible for federal funding to assist with instructional needs at the school in the areas of math, reading, and science. The information on the form may also be used to determine student’s eligibility for financial assistance in other programs such as the school based free and reduced lunch program. At Bataan Military Academy we do not have a lunch program, but we do use the information to establish student eligibility for financial aid requests that may be submitted to the school. **The information on this form is kept totally confidential and only released to the Title I Office of Albuquerque Public Schools (APS).**

STATION 6 – USNSCC DUES:
Dues will be collected. Cash, checks, or money orders will be accepted.

STATION 7 – CLASS SCHEDULES :
Cadets will turn in their Buff Card at Station 7 to receive their class schedules.

SCHEDULE CHANGES or CORRECTIONS: Please see the Counselor (Main Building top level) BEFORE proceeding to Station 8 - Textbooks.

STATION 8 - TEXTBOOK DISTRIBUTION (MAIN BUILDING – TOP LEVEL): Cadets will take their schedules to the Bookroom to receive their textbooks. Cadets will be responsible for the care and return of all textbooks issued to them. ***Textbooks that are lost, stolen, or damaged will be charged as a fine to the Cadet.***

Lockers will not be issued at Registration. Lockers will be issued by the coach during P.T. There is no charge for the use of lockers; however, Cadets are responsible to purchase locks to secure the lockers.
