SEA LION II RECRUIT AND PETTY OFFICER LEADERSHIP ACADEMY (POLA) are being offered from 16-30 July 2008 at the NM Army National Guard facility in Santa Clara (Silver City), New Mexico. Cadets from the Bataan Military Academy are required to complete a Recruit Training during the first year of membership in the United States Naval Sea Cadet Corps (USNSCC). Cadets who have E-2 status, have been members off the USNSCC for at least one year, and have successfully completed the NSCC *Seaman Course* may qualify to attend the advanced training Petty Officers' Leadership Academy (POLA) being offered during the training.

Cadets will sign-up for the RT or POLA in HQ.

Cadets must have a current USNSCC membership.

Cadets must have Local Orders signed by the Commanding Officer.

Uniform items, fees for RT/POLA, and USNSCC membership fees need to be paid while Academy staff members are available. After the last day of the school year, staff members will be on a part time schedule. Office hours will be very limited, and personnel who are assigned to process fees may not be available.

Membership and other fees need to be paid well enough in advance to allow processing time by National Headquarters. Do not wait until the last minute.

As with all USNSCC activities parents are responsible for transportation

After the training begins, if the CO determines that a Cadet is not displaying acceptable behavior, it is the parents' responsibility to come to the training site for the Cadet. As with all NSCC events and membership, there are no refunds.

Fee for training is \$150.00 per Cadet
