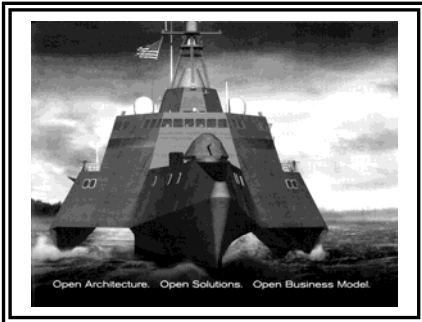

### SPRING BREAK STARTS MONDAY 15 MARCH 2010

A five (5) day spring break begins on Monday 15 March 2010. Cadets will be released on Friday 12 March 2010 following an All American Day celebration. (See article below.) The traditional Spring Break begins and continues until Cadets report for regular classes on Monday 22 March 2010.

### ALL AMERICAN DAY – FRIDAY 12 MARCH 2010.

BMA will host an All American Day on Friday. During the morning, Cadets will attend all of their classes. For noon chow, Cadets will be released to attend a cook-out in the park located north of the Academy. While in the park, Cadets will be allowed social time and have games and other activities. There will be an early release at 1400 hours (2:00 PM) located at the Academy. Parents, please arrange for early-release transportation and pick-up Cadets at the Academy. ### CHANGE YOUR CLOCKS–SPRING FORWARD–SATURDAY PM - 13 MARCH

- **MONDAY/TUESDAY 08-09 MARCH 2010 – 9-11 GRADES TAKE SHORT-CYCLE ASSESSMENT.** Seniors will have a late arrival (1000 hours) on Monday and Tuesday 8-9 March as grades 9-11 take the short-cycle assessment. We will be on the 'Late Arrival' schedule for all classes on these two days. Seniors will report at 1000 hours. Grades 9, 10, and 11 will report at regular time.
- **ALBUQUERQUE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS.** Albuquerque Foundation has twelve different scholarship programs for New Mexico students. Students must meet deadlines as awards begin in the fall semester. Additional information is available in Headquarters. Cadets are encouraged to investigate and take advantage of this opportunity.
- **USNSCC SUMMER TRAININGS LISTED ON BACK OF THIS CAPTAIN'S LOG.** Some of the nationally sponsored USNSCC training opportunities are listed on the reverse side of this Captain's Log. - **AFTER SCHOOL EXTRA MILITARY INSTRUCTION (EMI) STARTS MONDAY 08 MARCH 2010.** USNSCC Extra Military Instruction (EMI) is an opportunity for Cadets to have additional time to learn military protocol, military bearing, perform physical trainings, be provided with additional drill instruction, and perform community service. Structured after actual military procedures, EMI is used as a time to "re-teach" information. To this point at BMA, it has been held during selected Saturdays. Starting on Monday 08 March 2010, Cadets assigned to After School EMI will report promptly to the class following a five (5) minute passing period at 1520 hours (3:20 PM). If tardy, Cadets may be assigned additional duties. Cadets will be released at 1630 hours (4:30 PM). Headquarters will attempt to notify parents in advance. Parents will pick-up these Cadets following their release. Parents and Cadets signed an EMI agreement during BMA registration.
- **BATAAN CHANGES TO WHITE UNIFORMS ON 01 APRIL.** On 01 April 2010 the United States Navy traditionally changes the darker working blue uniform with long sleeves to the white uniform with short sleeves. Cadets need to plan for this required transition by acquiring whites and appurtenances from the Ship's Supply.
